- Virginia, Maryland, and/or District of Columbia Asbestos or Lead Inspector, Risk Assessor, Project Designer, and/or Project Monitor Certifications required; Licensure in other States is desirable.
- Successful completion of the NIOSH-582 Course or equivalent.
- Prior work experience should include: bulk sampling of regulated building materials, conducting indoor air quality studies, industrial hygiene workplace evaluations, project management and construction experience.
- Proficient in Microsoft® Word® and Excel®.
- Willingness and ability to regularly work in the field and outdoors. Out-of-area travel will be required on a limited basis. Off-hours work may also be required.
- Medical clearance to wear a respirator and must be able to lift 50 lbs.
- Must possess a valid U.S. driver's license and able to successfully pass a pre-employment background check and a drug screen, to include cannabis.
- Must be able to obtain, as a minimum, OMB Position of Public Trust and Federal Protective Services Favorable designations. Other clearance requirements for access to Federal facilities may be necessary and will be addressed on a case-by-case basis.
